Photography & Recording Policy

The use of photographic or recording equipment within WDL facilities is forbidden unless prior permission has been given by management. Such equipment includes cameras, mobile phones, tablets or other hand held devices.

1. Situations where permission may be granted

Where the Duty Officer is satisfied that:

- All those being photographed have given consent
- The photograph can be taken ensuring that no other person will be included inadvertently, ie. in the background, without that person's consent
- Consent of a parent/guardian is given for children under 12 yrs or vulnerable adults then photography may proceed, subject to the individual completing the authorised photography register.

Care must be taken in swimming pools to ensure no other person is included in the photograph. Photography of individuals in swimming pools will therefore be permitted only under the supervision of the WDL staff.

Consent is not required for public events where there is no reasonable expectation of privacy, eg. football tournaments, swimming galas, boxing matches, etc.

Photography during birthday parties may be permitted; the hirer is responsible for ensuring consent from participants' parents/guardians.

2. Situations where permission will not be granted

Photography will not be permitted where there is a reasonable expectation of privacy, eg. In exercise classes, changing areas and toilet/shower areas.

Should any customer complain or express concern regarding the use of any photographic or recording equipment, permission will be withdrawn.
