Child Wellbeing & Protection in Sport

Child Wellbeing and Protection in Sport (CWPS) supersedes the previous Safeguarding and Protecting Children (SPC) course. The training will provide coaches with the knowledge on child wellbeing and protection that will give you the confidence to deal with issues that may arise in your role working with children. Before attending the 3 hour course there is a prerequisite eLearning module which must be completed. Qualification lasts 3 years. Participants need to be 16+.

Child Wellbeing & Protection Officer Training

This workshop is for Child protection officers and supersedes 'In Safe Hands 1 & 2'. It will give those with the responsibility for the welfare and protection of children in their club or organisation the knowledge and skill to manage any concern. Child Wellbeing & Protection in Sport is a pre-requisite for this course. Qualification lasts 3 years. Participants need to be 18+.

Emergency Paediatric First Aid

This comprehensive course covers a wide range of first aid skills related to infants and children as well as equipping the first aider to apply first aid to a range of specific injuries and illnesses. This course will provide the leaner with an IQL Emergency Paediatric First Aid qualification which is Ofqual accredited and meets the requirements of the Early Years and Child Care Register. Qualification lasts 3 years. Participants need to be 16+.

This is a 6 hour course split over 2 evenings of 3 hours.
