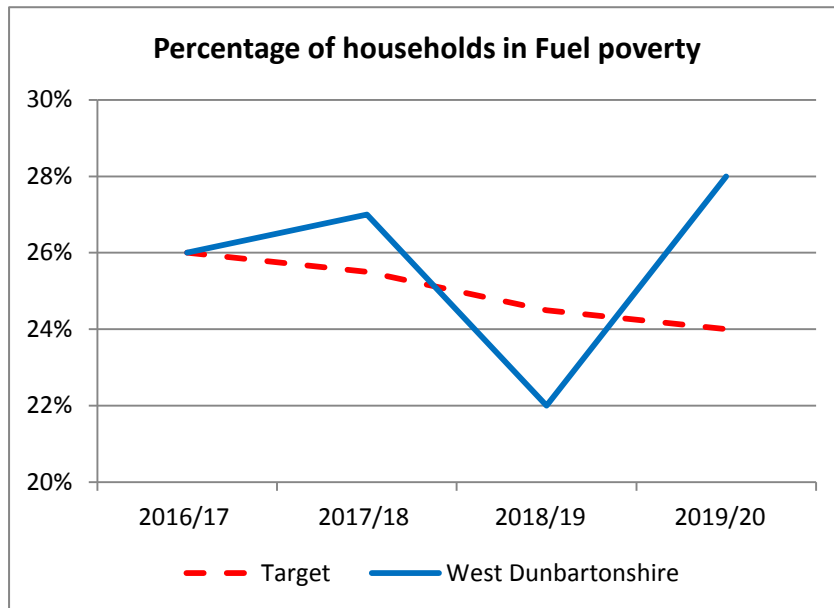

What does the data say?



Results for 2019/20 show that progress from the previous year has reduced with an increase in the percentage of houses in fuel poverty of 4% points and is tracking at a higher level than the target.

This performance level is lower than the figure for Scotland which is 25%.

Working 4U and West Dunbartonshire Citizens Advice Bureau are working together, through the Information and Advice Partnership, to address fuel poverty across West Dunbartonshire. This includes support and advice to access appropriate tariffs and addressing and dealing with debt.

This will complement the work being done by Housing Services to ensure each house meets or exceeds energy rating standards.
